Part 1 - Mounting to the mounts

IMPORTANT! For safety reasons, this tablet mount adaptor must be secured to a mount capable of supporting the combined weight of the mount and tablet.

1 Attach the tablet mount adaptor to the VESA 100 x 100 mount by M6 x20 screws (A) as shown (see Fig. 1). Do not overtighten these screws



Part 2 - Final Assembly

IMPORTANT! Use extra care during this part of the installation. *NOTE*: The Lock/Release levers on the TMA-1 have 3 positions that control the ability to adjust the opening and closing width of the arms. The left and right positions are locking positions and the middle position is Unlocked/Neutral. Please make sure to have the lever in the Unlocked/Neutral position before attempting to adjust the arms of the adaptor to keep from damaging the unit. Once your tablet is loaded and the adjustable arms are tight against the sides of the tablet, please move the lever either to the right or left locked position to firmly secure the tablet in place.

Open the tablet mount adaptor, make sure you can load your tablet in the adaptor easily. (see Fig. 2).



2 Load your tablet in and adjust the tablet mount adaptor size according to your tablet size, make sure the tablet is stable and safe in the tablet adaptor (see Fig. 3). Do not release the tablet until the tablet is securely placed in the tablet adaptor and the lock /release lever is in the locked position.



3 Periodically clean your tablet with a dry cloth. Inspect all screws and hardware at regular intervals to ensure that no connections have become loose over time. Re-tighten as needed.
